Alcohol interlocks at Ringnes

- Ringnes AS is a responsible producer and supplier of alcoholic beverages. For us it is important to emphasize zero tolerance when it comes to alcohol and driving. We focus on this through our responsible concept "Enjoy responsibly" (*Nytes ansvarlig*), and installation of alcohol interlocks in our trucks is a natural part and contribution to this concept.
- Alcohol interlocks was introduced as standard in all new trucks from 2010.
- At the end of 2012, 130 out of 180 trucks will be equipped with alcohol interlocks .
- The remaining trucks will get alcohol interlocks installed continuously.
- Also technical personnel will get alcohol interlocks installed in their new vans in 2012 (20-25 cars).



Our experiences

- It was a top management decision to install alcohol interlocks in our trucks and vans.
- However, we have received no negative reactions from drivers or union.
- In practice, the driver has to ree-blow every hour after the engine has been switched off.
- So far we have not experienced one single “red light blow” at Ringnes.
