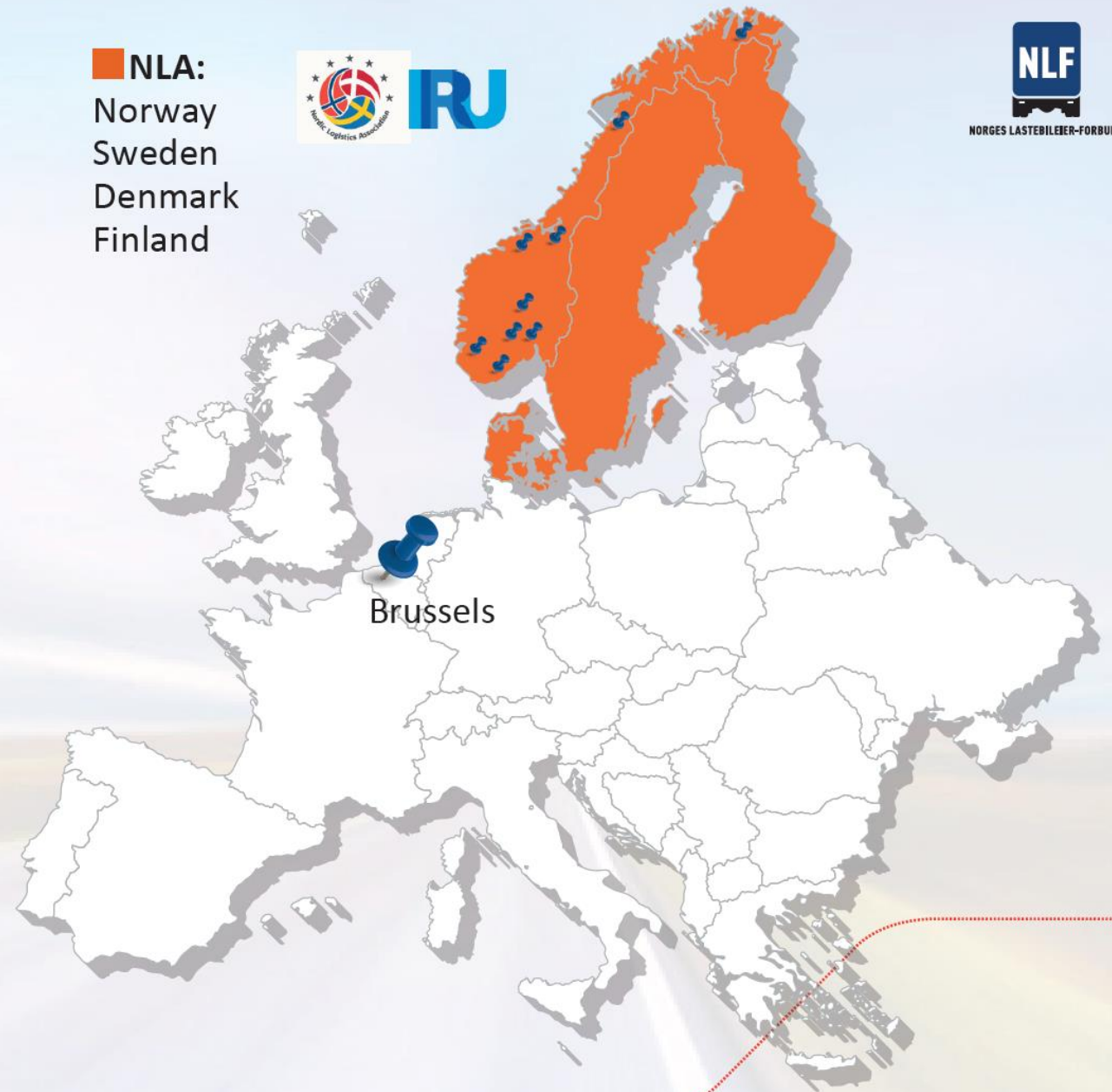
- 76% of NLF's members have 10 or less trucks in daily operation

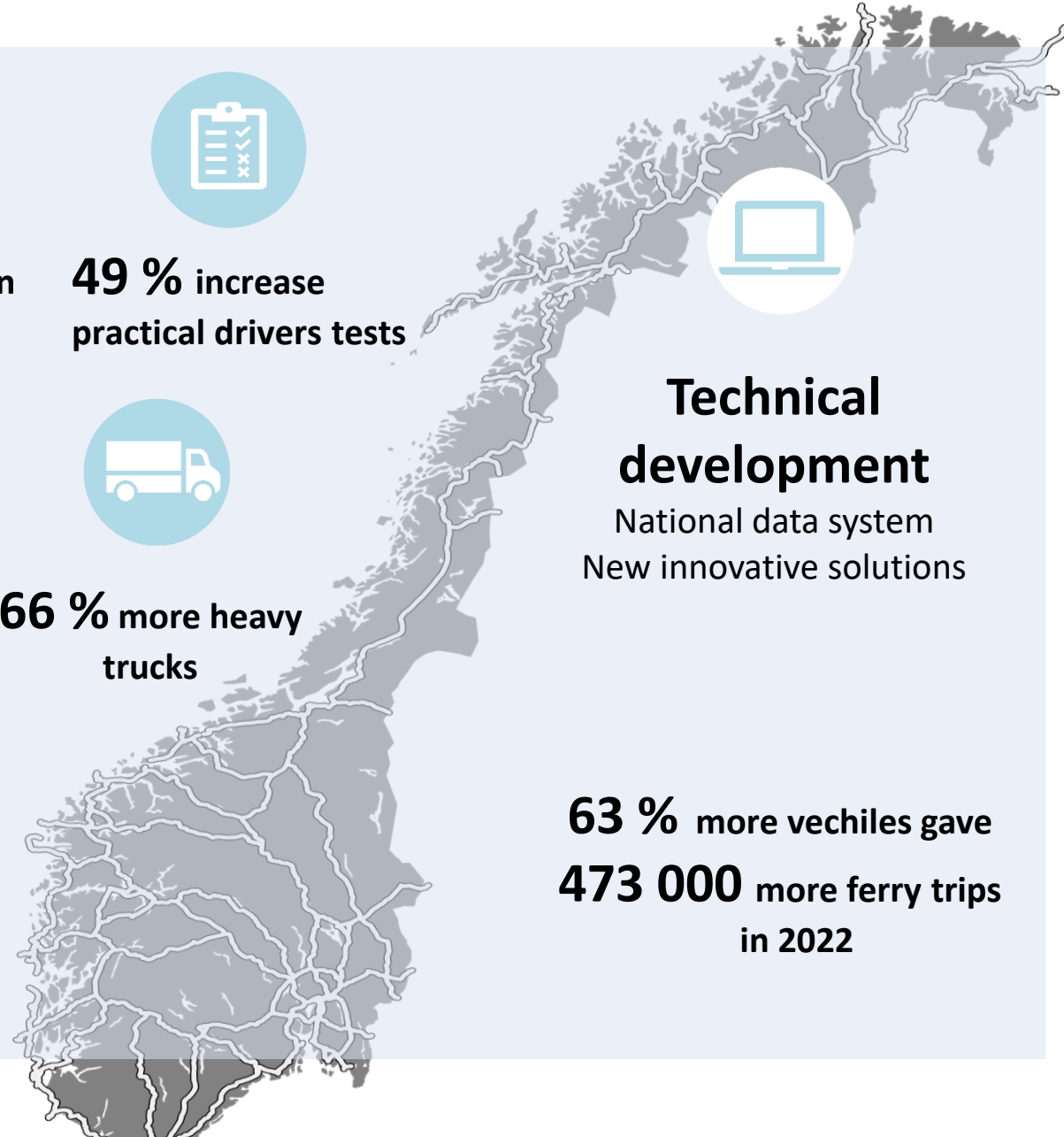

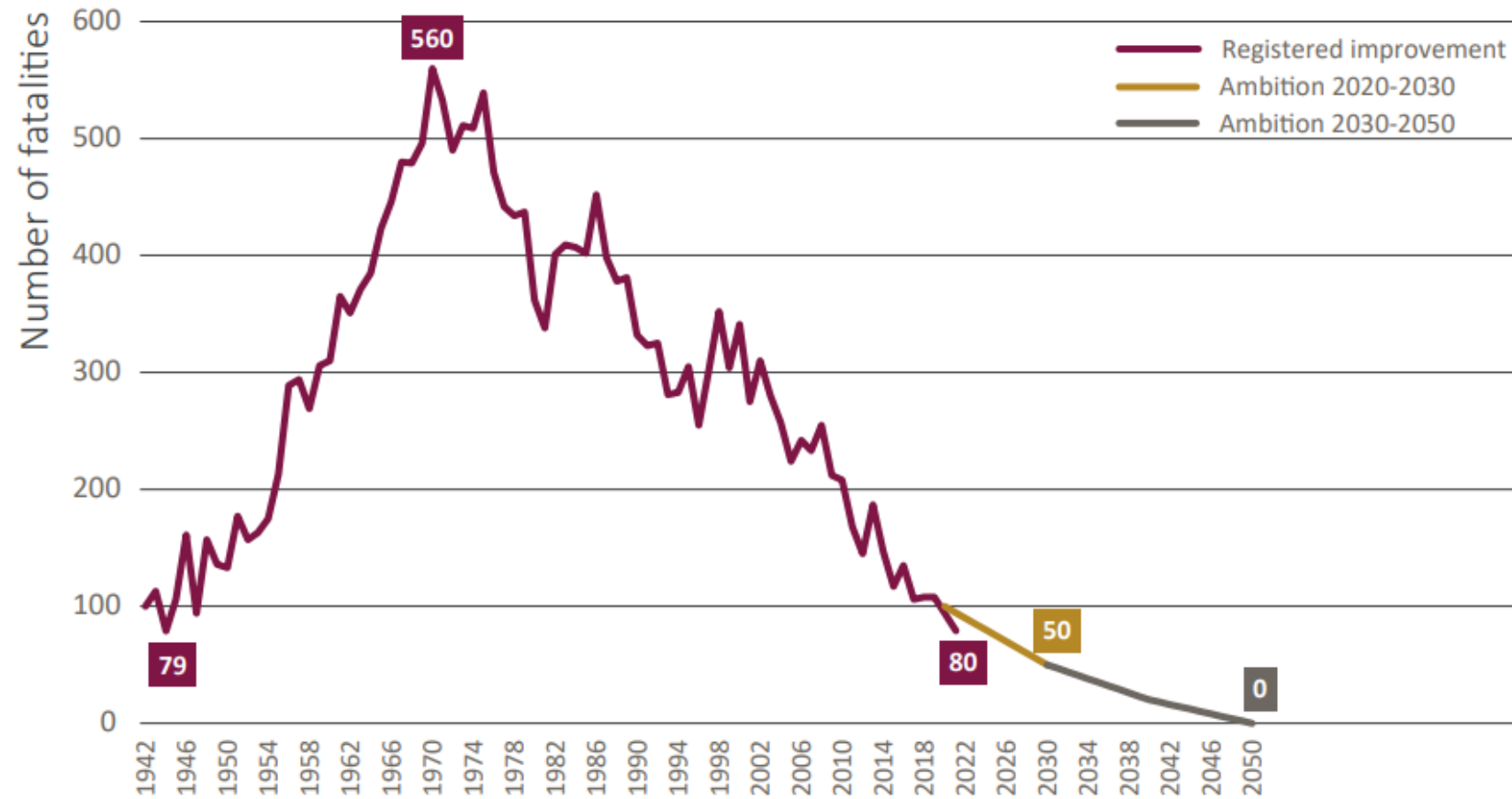


Figure 1.3 – Development in the number of people killed – situation registered for the period 1942-2021, and graph indicating our ambition for the improvement towards 2050.

Safe sustainable transport carried out by responsible carriers

Norges Lastebileier-Forbund



Fair Transport is a quality and certification program developed by NLF to highlight transport companies that deliver traffic-safe, sustainable and responsible transport.

The purpose is to show how the certified companies develop their roadtransport, with a particular focus on strengthening traffic safety, reducing emissions of environmental and climate gases and ensuring good social conditions for employees.

45 requirements – three main areas



Traffic safety:

- traffic safety policy
- participate in an approved traffic safety program
- detect and process deviations in their HSE-system
- drivers check the vehicle on a daily basis, and are trained in securing cargo
- Monitor and follow up driving time and rest periods due to regulations, and follow up on deviations



Emission - environment:

- environmental policy
- use fleet management systems to map and improve driving style
- have a replacement plan for older vehicles
- utilize the load capacity of the transport assignments to the extent that they can control this
- environmental report

45 requirements – three main areas



Responsibility – responsible employer:

- quality policy
- working environment policy
- have written employment agreements with all our employees, which comply with Norwegian law
- system for procedures and efforts in regard to Health, Safety and Environment (HSE)
- safety representative (employee)
- carry out safety training
- pay the taxes and fees - and have submitted annual accounts
- annual report for the HSE work

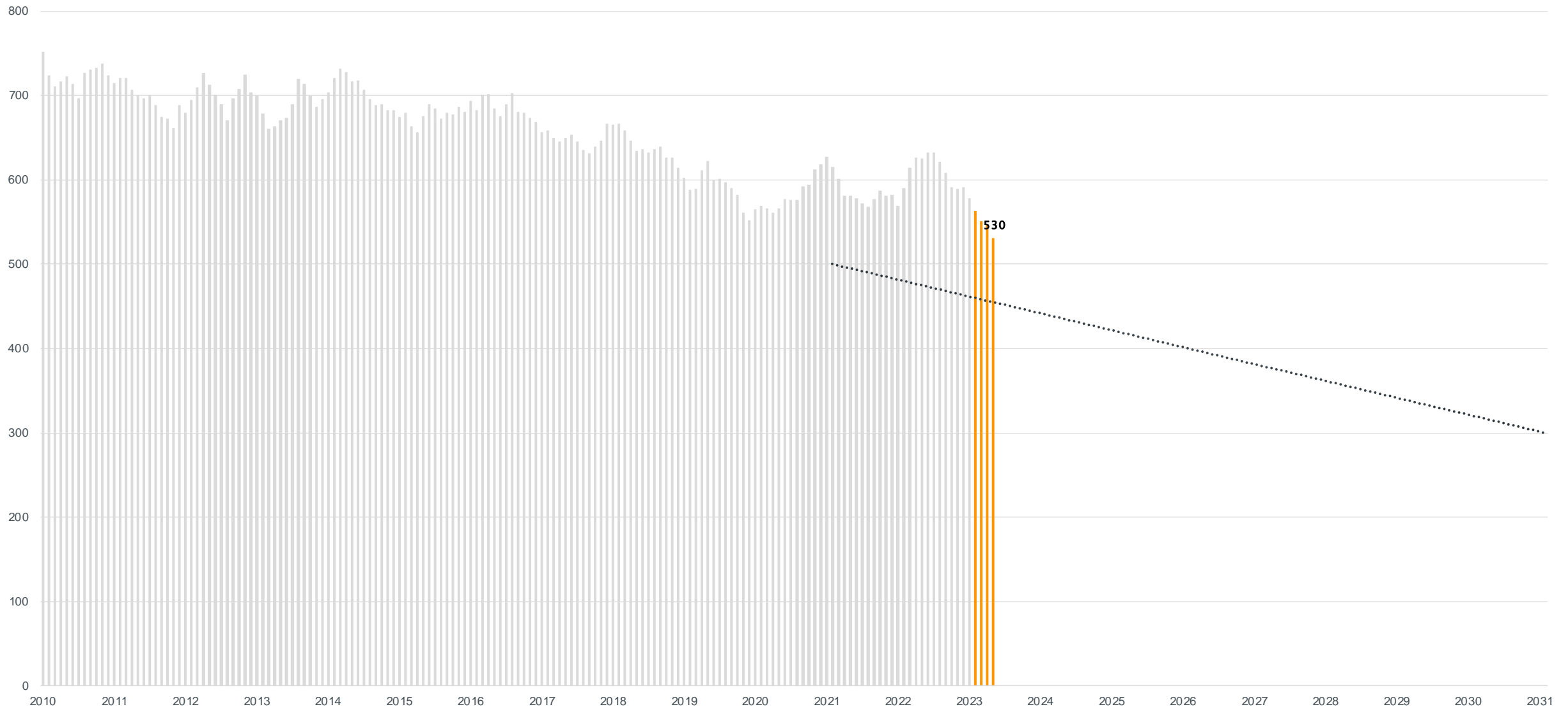

Norway – 0 vision

Good, but not perfect

Between 500 – 700 seriously injured in traffic accidents every year
116 killed in 2022, 87 in 2021.

2020: 17 killed per 1 million – average Europe: 42

1 in 3 accidents are caused by inattention

Poor road standard leads to accidents

3 road ownership levels: State/Government – regional – local – private

9 of 10 killed on regional roads. Nearly 90 % higher risk of being killed or seriously injured compared to national roads.
